- Must plan to attend an accredited college or university in the state of Texas
- ★ Must plan to enroll as a full-time college student in the fall 2023 semester
- ★ Must be graduating from high school during the current year

Complete the online application between March 1 and May 26, 2023, including the submisson of:

- ★ Your high school transcript
- ★ Your SAT/ACT scores (if taken)
- ★ A letter of recommendation from an administrator, UIL coach, teacher, or counselor
- ★ A copy of the first two pages of your parent or guardian's most recent IRS 1040 form
- ★ A copy of your financial aid letter
